 Actively engage the youth through programs that will incarnate their civic consciousness and love for the environment





 Create island models (Mindoro Oriental, Sibuyan, Palawan, Sorsogon, Guimaras, Batangas) that encourage the convergence approach between and among national government agencies, academe and civil society to lift people out of poverty through programs on agriculture, environmental protection tourism, enterprise and skills building
