RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

[on the report of the Second Committee ( $\lambda/47/719$ )]

47/193. Observance of World Day for Water

The General Assembly,

Recalling the relevant provisions of chapter 18 of Agenda 21, adopted by the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development, 1/

Considering that the extent to which water resource development contributes to economic productivity and social well-being is not widely appreciated, although all social and economic activities rely heavily on the supply and quality of fresh water,

Considering also that, as populations and economic activities grow, many countries are rapidly reaching conditions of water scarcity or facing limits to economic development,

<u>Considering further</u> that the promotion of water conservation and sustainable management requires public awareness at local, national, regional and international levels,

1. Decides to declare 22 March of each year Morld Day for Water, to be observed starting in 1993, in conformity with the recommendations of the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development contained in chapter 18 of Agenda 21;  $\underline{1}/$

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 258

ENJOINING ALL INSTRUMENTALITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT TO JOIN THE GLOBAL OBSERVANCE OF WORLD WATER DAY ON MARCH 22, 1996 TO START THE 1996 WATER CONSERVATION YEAR, AND CREATING AN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO PLAN AND PREPARE FOR T

WHEREAS, the United Nations General Assembly has declared the date March 22 of each year as the World Day for Water in conformity with the recommendations of the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development and has adopted the theme "Water for Thirsty Cities" for the World Day celebration in 1996;

WHEREAS, the government, as signatory to the Agenda 21 of the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED), has formulated and is vigorously advocating the Philippine Strategy for Sustainable Development (PSSD) which includes emphasis on water as a limited resource;

whereas, pursuant to these commitments and in response to the alarming degradation of the status of the country's water resources, the government has initiated a series of intensive nationwide multi-sectoral consultations culminating in the Water Summit in December 1994 which was immediately followed by the enactment of R.A. 8041, also known as the Water Crisis Act, in June 1995;

WHEREAS, corollary to the present effort of attaining a sustainable development of our water resources, the government must demonstrate its solidarity with the international community in advocating water conservation and sustainable utilization;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS**, President of the Republic of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. The nationwide observance of Water Conservation Year starting 22 March 1996. March 22 this year and in every year thereafter, is hereby declared World Water Day to coincide with such celebration by the international community of nations with the objective of instilling awareness in all concerned on the importance of water conservation.

- 2. Invitos States to devote the Day, as appropriate in the national context, to concrete activities such as the promotion of public maximums through the publication and diffusion of documentaries and the organization of conferences, round tables, seminars and expositions related to the conservation and development of water resources and the implementation of the recommendations of Agenda 21;
- 3. Invites the Secretary-General to make recommendations on ways and means by which the United Nations Secretariat could, within existing resources and without prejudice to ongoing activities, assist countries in organizing their national activities for the observance of World Day for Water;
- 4. Requests the Secretary-General to make the necessary arrangements in order to ensure the success of the observance of World Day for Water by the United Nations;
- <u>Also requests</u> the Secretary-General to focus observance of World Day for Water by the United Nations on a particular theme relating to the conservation of water resources;
- Recommends that the Commission on Sustainable Development, in the execution of its mandate, attach priority to the implementation of chapter 18 of Agenda 21.
